Scope & definition of Horticulture for Health

"Horticulture for health, [is] an umbrella term referring to wide-ranging activities, programs and services, where horticulture used in various capacities and applications can positively impact health.... the horticulture for health framework captures the exponential growth and scope of activities across disciplines and sectors, where practices in health services, education, food production, business, landscape architecture and green industry promote human health....The framework categorizes diverse initiatives like mobile food trucks, digitized horticulture technology, ecotherapy, parks Rx, forest breathing, and therapeutic horticulture, as parts of a greater whole, where "the multi-sectoral nature and horticulture-specific commonality of [these] each focus on improving human health and where horticulture plays a significant role" (Fleming, 2021; Fleming et al., 2021).
